Empowering Life skills of Girl Students through Health Programme and Computer Literacy:-

The empowerment of women, or the empowerment of women in modern society, has drawn a lot of attention when it comes to economic growth. It can also serve to draw attention to strategies for addressing other marginalized genders in particular political, social, and economic contexts. Our college is dedicated to working toward bringing about the desired socio-economic and political transformation. One of our biggest successes, the large proportion of female students at our college, inspires. The organization acknowledged the link between education and health.

The institution contributes top-notch resources that can bridge the socio cultural existence divides and takes part in several activities to advance society as a whole. Our college has been recognized as one of the best organizations in the field of community services because of the critical location it chose to establish a healthy environment for girls in this isolated and impoverished area, Digras, in the Yavatmal district of Maharashtra state, India.

1. Goals: -

- Raising awareness and disseminating information about the different nutrients found in various food sources and how to put together a balanced diet using what is readily available.
- To impart knowledge on the anatomy, physiology, and maintenance of physical and mental health.
- To provide knowledge on the origins, transmission mechanisms, and preventative measures for a range of prevalent illnesses.
- To motivate girls to take part in nationwide campaigns for disease awareness, control, and eradication.
- To provide knowledge regarding environmental cleanliness and personal hygiene.
- To educate people on first aid and its significance in unintentional situations.
- To provide information about government initiatives and programs pertaining to women's and girls' empowerment.
- To spread knowledge about yoga, meditation, and fitness in one's lifetime.
- To equip children to manage all life's important circumstances.
- To encourage girls to receive vaccinations in order to build immunity against a range of illnesses.
- To treat girls more fairly in the social, economic, and political spheres.

2. Context: -

A person's health is extremely important; for women, in particular, it is fundamental to what it is to be human. Our college is dedicated to changing this situation by emphasizing women's empowerment more. Digras is in the middle, neither very advanced nor underdeveloped. Many female students at our college have made some

progress, but many lack a clear understanding of their place in society. This college has a coeducational system and is working hard to promote gender equality. To address a variety of difficulties, it has a dedicated women's anti-harassment cell called the Internal Complaints Committee.

During the 2023–2024 academic years, the college held a number of events, workshops, and programs. On March 14, 2023, the Department of Zoology sponsored a "Blood Group Testing and Awareness Camp" for the students who took part in the NSS special camp at Harsule and awareness program. Along with this intellectual session on the Indian Constitution, Ghar Ghar Savidhan and Gaon Gaon Savidhan, awareness camps on cleanliness, the banishment of plastic, water management, preserving girls' education, planting trees, and health checkups were planned.

The Department of Home Economics held competitions in Modak and garland creation, as well as poster presentation. The Department of Home Economics provided training in baby food preparation to female students. To promote self-employment and entrepreneurship, the Department of Home-Economics organized rangoli training and rangoli creating competition from grains for female students.

Department of Home-economics organized a program on 'Preparation of Bengali Mithai making'.

The Department of Home Economics held a workshop on kitchen cleanliness and waste food management. A personality development programme for female students was organized by the Department of Home Economics and the college NSS section.

Department of Home-economics visited Interior Decorated houses of Digras for to know about how to decorate house with latest various technology. The same Department organized the social Programs -Haldi kumkum on the occasion of Makar Sankranti 2024.

Department of Home Economics observed 'Nutrition Week' also and guided the girl students about health and nutrition. Department also observed 'Breast feeding Week' and guided the girl students about importance of breast feeding.

Department of Home Economics and NSS Unit of our college organized a camp of Health checkup and Hemoglobin count for girl students. International women's day was observed by college internal complaints committee and Department of zoology.

Department of Home Economics organized various activities for college girls like Inauguration of Home Economics Department, Visit to Ambai Super Market on, Nutrition beauty competition, Visit to dumb and deaf school, Rangoli making competition from grains., Health Checkup camp, Teachers day celebration (Event Management),Guest lecture on how to event management, International Women Day celebration, Organization of Speech competition on the occasion of International women's day, Birthday Party programme, Anand Melawa, Innovative dish programme ,Visit to interior decorated house, Awareness about rubella vaccination programme ,Workshop on personality Development, Guest lecture on women awareness, One Day workshop on techniques of Bengali Mithai making ,ICT computing skill programme.
